



# German Junior Open 2009

## European Junior Grand Prix Tournament

### DATE

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> May – Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2009 (Whitsun)

The tournament will start on Saturday at 9.00 am. The last Final will start at 03.00 pm on Monday.

### VENUE

Germering is a neighbouring town to the west of Munich.

If necessary a second venue will be used. Transport will be provided.

### CATEGORIES

Boys and Girls under 19, under 17, under 15 and under 13.

Maximum 64 players will be accepted in each category.

Players may only enter one category.

### ELIGIBILITY

The German Junior Open is open to all players under the age of 13, 15, 17 and 19 on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2009 as appropriate.

### SEEDING

The seeding will be carried out by the ESF in conjunction with the Tournament Director (TD) using the European Junior Ranking valid at the closing date. All players with an ESF Junior Ranking will be seeded by ESF. The TD is responsible for seeding non-European players who do not have an ESF Junior Ranking. (Once a player has participated in a tournament on the Junior Circuit he/she will be included on the ranking list and seeded accordingly under D.2.a). The Tournament Director may seek advice from the ESF about the seeding of these players.

### MATCHES & SCORING

All matches will be played as best of five games, under the rules of the WSF. PAR 11 scoring will be used at all tournaments on the ESF Junior Circuit (to 2 clear points). All game scores will be reported in full.

### REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

### PRIZES

There will be prize money in the under 19 Boys/Girls categories. In all other categories, there will be gift prizes. Trophies will be awarded in all categories.





## INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance. All players have to wear approved protective eye guards on court.

All entries must be made through / endorsed by the relevant national federation. Any entry not endorsed by a player's national federation will not be accepted. All entries will be acknowledged and published on the tournament website <http://www.german-junior-open.de>. Details of the centre, hotel and travel information will be sent to entrants or their association by e-mail.

## ENTRY FEE

- **Tournament package 1: € 196,00** per person, including 2 nights (Saturday – Sunday) bed and breakfast accommodation in double/triple rooms, 5 meals (dinner for Saturday & Sunday; lunch for Saturday & Sunday & Monday) at the Club, transportation between arrival/departure point and hotel.
- **Tournament package 2: € 248,00** per person, including 3 nights (Friday – Sunday) bed and breakfast accommodation in double/triple rooms, 5 meals (dinner for Saturday & Sunday; lunch for Saturday & Sunday & Monday) at the Club, transportation between arrival/departure point and hotel.
- *Extra charge for single room (package 1) **€ 62 per person + breakfast included***
- *Extra charge for single room (package 2) **€ 93 per person + breakfast included***
- **Extra night (Thursday or Monday) with breakfast : € 52 in double room, p.p.n., € 83 single room p.p.n.**
- **Entry Fee** without package is **€ 46** (The Fee includes the ESF levy of 3 Euros)

## TRANSPORT

- Individuals arriving at Munich Railway Station Ost (East) will be met on arrival if the organisers receive travel details by 15<sup>th</sup> May.  
For those arriving by air, the train service between the airport and the city centre provides the quickest means of travel. You take S-Bahn no. 8 (S8) which gets you to Munich Railway Station Ost (East) in 31 minutes. The motorway link is congested, especially during the busy morning and evening commuter periods, and hold ups and delays are to be expected.
- Players leaving after the event will be dropped off at Munich Railway Station Ost (leaving from the hotel) or at S-Bahn Station Germering (leaving from the venue – 51 minutes to the airport).

## EYE GUARDS

All competitors at ESF approved Junior tournaments must wear approved protective eye guards, manufactured to an appropriate national safety standard, properly over the eyes at all times during competition play. This includes the knock-up. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the quality of the product is satisfactory for the purpose. Players will not be allowed to compete without this protection.

## ESF REGULATIONS & PENALTIES

The tournament is part of the ESF Junior Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website [www.europeansquash.com](http://www.europeansquash.com) MNAs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

The following penalties will apply, in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines, Section E.4.a, E.4.b & E.4.c:

- E.4.a) If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office within two days after the final day of the tournament (email: [esf@europeansquash.com](mailto:esf@europeansquash.com); fax +44 1424 774879). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

- b) If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

- c) If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to the ESF office within two days of the final day of the tournament. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
